Who is Shoalhaven Community Transport

We are a community based organisation offering affordable transport for clients who are frail aged, disabled, geographically isolated (and their carers), who reside within the Local Government Area.



Aboriginal Individual Transport

We deliver a Culturally appropriate service. We provide access and equity to all eligible Community members for Individual transport, for Medical appointments, Visits to Local hospitals/ Nursing homes.



Door to Door Service

We offer a door to door service by a dedicated group of volunteers. Volunteers are an integral and a major asset to our organisation. We have one Indigenous volunteer and encourage others to volunteer.

When is Service available

Transport provided is based on availability of vehicles. Transport for funerals within the 100km radius is a priority. Every effort is made to accommodate clients.

There are NO bookings on the day.

Bookings are Essential

Bookings must be made at least 48 hours prior to the date of local appointments.

Out of area medical/specialists appointments must be made at least 5 days prior to appointment.
